ORDER

1. This Order shall dispose of the Appeal dated 06-03-2025 filed by the appellant, Sh. Shyam Lal Gupta S/o Late Sh. Bhoop Singh R/o 13/10, Indira Vikas Colony, Opp. Nirankari Colony, Delhi-110009.

2. The Brief Facts of the case are as under:-

- That the Appellant is said to be the son of late proprietor of the Fair Price Shop No. 3283 which was operating in the name of M/s Bhoop Singh from the year 1972 under District North of Food, Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department of GNCT of Delhi.
- That in 1994, the appellant had tendered his resignation citing reason of his ill health and which was accepted in 1994 itself.
- And that father of the appellant, who was the license holder of the said FPS died on 23-11-2005.

iv. And that the appellant filed an Appeal and wished to withdraw the resignation tendered by his deceased father on 06-03-2025 and was numbered as 02 of 2025.

3. After hearing the contentions, examining their written submissions and perusing other relevant records placed in the case file, it is noted that-

- That the license holder of the said FPS had relinquished the authorization of the said FPS No. 3283 on his own free Will in year 1994 citing reason of his ill health.
- And that the said license holder Sh. Bhoop Singh expired on 23-11-2005.
- And that son of the deceased former FPS license holder has filed the instant Appeal on 06-03-2025, after a gap of more than 25 years and that the delay could not be explained by the appellant.
- The Appellant has not produced any legal provision or precedence where ward of a deceased FPS holder is allegedly allowed to withdraw resignations tendered by their parents 20 years after his/her death.

4. In the light of the aforesaid, the instant Appeal, being devoid of any merit is accordingly dismissed.

5. Parties be informed accordingly.
